Top ChatGPT Prompts:

As the capabilities of OpenAI evolve, there are more and more ways that UX researchers can use ChatGPT. Here are the top prompts for researchers, from researchers:

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1. Prompt: I'm seeking methods to collect qualitative data from [user group] about their experience using [product or service].
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This prompt will help you understand the best strategies to gather qualitative data from users regarding their interactions with your product or service. To utilize this prompt, insert the relevant details into the variables:

- [user group]: Specify the target user group for data collection, such as existing customers, potential customers, or a specific demographic.
- [product or service]: Provide details about the specific product or service.²

For instance, a completed prompt could read: “I’m seeking methods to collect qualitative data from existing customers about their experience using our mobile app.”

2. Prompt: I need to design a survey that captures user feedback on the usability of [product or service].

This prompt will scope all the necessary components of the survey, including demographics and questions to ask that will help you dig into product usability.³

You can edit the prompt to “Design a survey that captures user feedback on the usability of [product or service].” This prompt will actually design the survey for you, giving you a strong starting point to work off of.

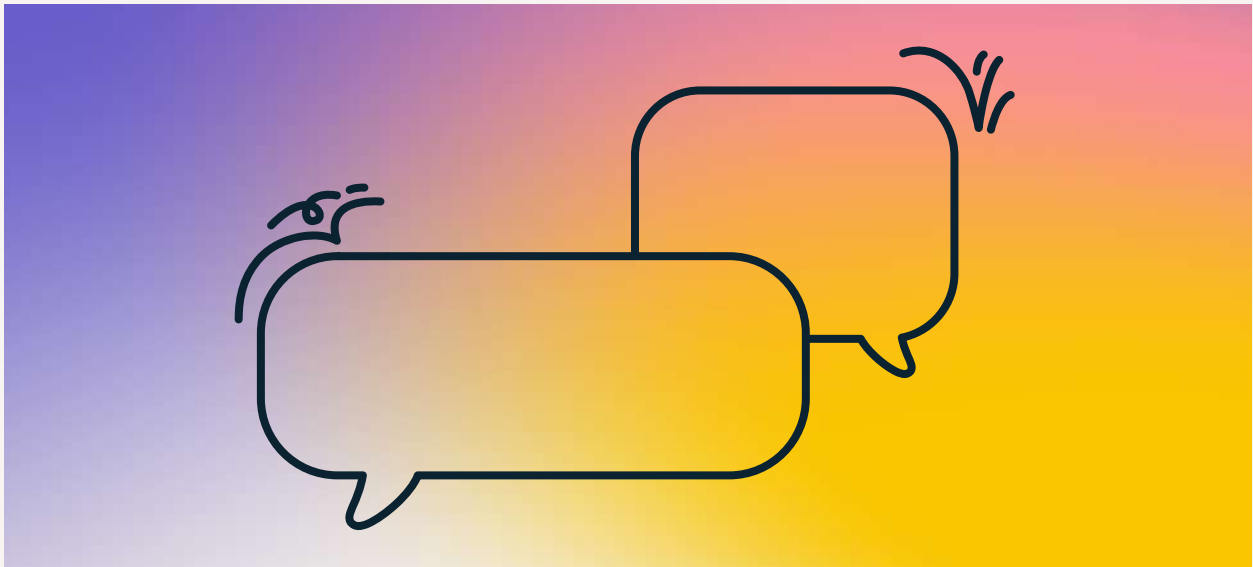

3. Prompt: Write a script for a moderated research interview with [user group] on the usability of [product or service].⁴

An interview script for moderated studies is an essential component of the research process. An effective script asks the right questions to answer your research questions while still having a conversational cadence.

With this prompt, researchers can have ChatGPT do some of the heavy lifting and create an outline for the interview sessions.

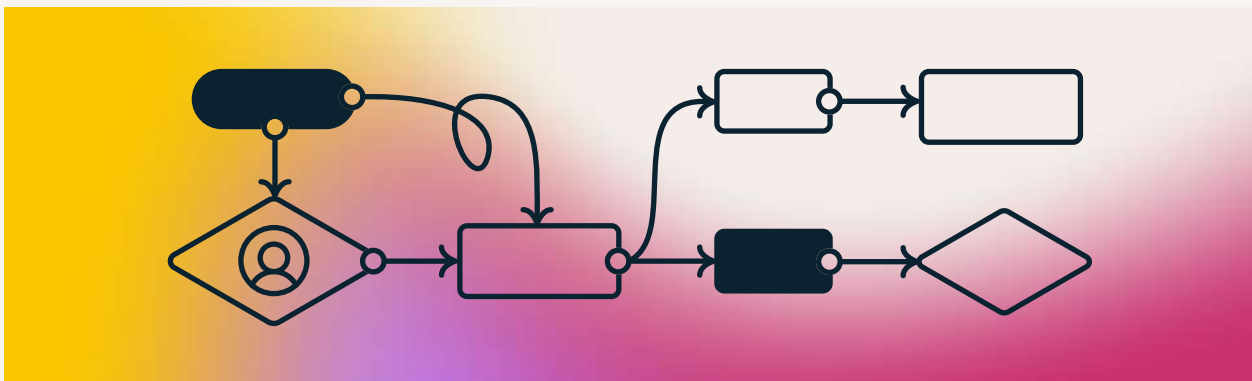
Top ChatGPT Prompts (cont'd):
